General Information and Rules for the National Social Work Quiz

- The quiz is open to undergraduate and postgraduate students of Social Work (BSW and MSW).
- The quiz is designed to create awareness and interest in social work and to test your knowledge, hence it is free of cost.
- You must fill in your basic personal information before starting the quiz. Your email/phone number will be authenticated by a One Time Password (OTP).
- You will have to attempt 40 multiple-choice questions, each carrying 2.5 marks; there is no negative marking.
- The quiz must be completed within 40 minutes; you may submit earlier and press the tab to close the quiz. You can quit whenever you desire.
- You can appear only once in the quiz; therefore, you should ensure a stable internet connection.

- The quiz will be accessible only during the scheduled date and time; late submissions will not be accepted.
- Scores will be visible after submission; official certificates will be sent later via email.
- The organizers may verify your identity or academic enrollment if required.
- The decision of the organizers will be final in case of any disputes.

Ethical Guidelines for Participants

- As a future professional, you are expected to act with honesty, fairness, and respect for the learning process.
- By participating, you commit to upholding the core values of social work, including integrity, responsibility, and ethical conduct.
- Avoid any form of malpractice, dishonesty, or misrepresentation during the quiz.

- You are expected to maintain confidentiality and not share the questions with anyone.
- Refrain from discussing, copying, or circulating quiz content in any form after participation.
- Take this as an opportunity to test your own knowledge sincerely rather than focusing solely on scores.
- Participants must attempt the quiz independently without using external help or resources.
