Prof. Pranab Chatterjee

Prof Chatterjee has completed his undergraduate in Social Work from Visva-Bharati (1959), Master's in Social Work from University of Tennessee (1961) & Master's in Sociology from University of Chicago (1963) and PhD in Sociology from University of Chicago (1967). Prof. Chatterjee started his journey in academia from Gads Hill Centre (A settlement house in the west side of Chicago), Research Fellow at University of Chicago (1965-1967), then he joined Case Western Reserve University as Assistant Professor. He has served and held key positions at Mandel Centre for Non-profit Management, Case Western Reserve University, Grace Longwell Coyle Professor Emeritus, Case Western Reserve University.



Prof. Chatterjee has over 40 research papers and five books to his credit and presented more than 50 papers in the seminar/conferences in his 41 years of career span in academia. He is authored book titled 'Contemporary Human Behaviour Theory' published by Allyn & Bacon which has been widely appreciated by readers besides other books titled 'Repackaging the Welfare State' (1999) & 'Approaches to the Welfare State' (1996) by NASW Press; 'Structure of Non-profit Management' (1993) by University Press, Lanham; and 'The Transferability of Social Technology' (1990) by Mellen, New York.

He is also enriching the knowledge base of social work profession through personal endeavours after retirement. His articles on human development, social welfare, health care system etc. have been appreciated widely. He was Editor-in-Chief of The Journal of Applied Social Sciences (1978-2001); Member, Editorial Board, Journal of Social Work Education, (1988-91); Editor, Sociological Practice Letter (1991-93); Member, Editorial Board, Journal of Sociology and Social Welfare (since 1977); Reader, The Academy of Management Review, (1992-94); Reader, The Academy of Management Journal (1993-95); and Publication Consultant to Allyn & Bacon; Simon & Schuster; Prentice-Hall; Jossey Bass.

Prof. Chatterjee has been the Member of American Sociological Association, Society for the Study of Social Problems, Council on Social Work Education, National Association of Social Workers, and The Academy of Management.
